5. How did you get the name ATX Cypher?



Born in Hopkins, SC, but later moved to West Columbia after my parent's divorce in 1991. Alumnus of Brookland Cayce High, graduating in 1996. Attended the Kenneth Shuler School of Cosmetology and became licensed as a cosmetologist in 2000. Currently living in Columbia, SC, employed by Receivable Solutions as a medical scheduler with emphasis as a leader over my department.

For several years, there was pain, darkness, and emptiness in my life.

I was faced with bullying from others, depression, and suicidal attempts. Becoming a single parent to my son at an early age was not easy.

At the age of four, my son lost his father due to a drug overdose.

How am I to raise my son alone?

As time passed, I became involved in toxic relationships, started having mental breakdowns. Life for me was numb; I began to suffocate my pain with negative feelings and behaviors, not realizing the harm I was inflicting upon myself.



I decided to return to my mother's house because of my son. I later became involved in a promising relationship and moved to North Carolina with this gentleman. The union of this relationship brought forth the blessing of my daughter. The relationship with this gentleman became toxic leading to failed suicidal attempts. The relationship soon ended, and I returned to South Carolina.


After returning to South Carolina, I continued my career as a hairstylist. I didn't fully understand who I was. I was often invited to attend church. I would always decline the offer, until one day I accepted. When I entered the church I heard the pastor speaking. I felt he was talking directly to me and me only. I then knew it was time for me to begin to share the untold truths about my life, helping others to understand that everyone has a story to tell. By confessing the truths of my life, I have assisted others from not committing suicide and removing themselves from toxic relationships.

The ability to share my failures and triumphs with all sexes, races, and nationalities has allowed one to gain strength, courage, and realize no one has to face their challenges alone. There are others like them, and we must stand together as one. We must seek God; pray harder; believe in ourselves; and surround ourselves with positivity.

The sharing of my life's obstacles and triumphs has led to the development of the "Eye Told You Movement," in which I am the founder and CEO. The Eye Told You Movement motto: Be the change You Desire. The Eye Told You Movement inspires one to the ability to change their current vision of themselves to see a positive reflection that lies ahead. Since 2018, we have hosted fashion shows that depict a story about everyday life situations.

The goal for my life is to become a world-known motivational speaker, the CEO of multiple businesses instilling positive energy, self-love, having a podcast and displaying the ability for others to become successful at achieving their goals despite the history of their past. Because we are faced with everyday life struggles and uphold ourselves in the way society views us, I challenge YOU to set and achieve your goals regardless of your past. History should not be a repeat of itself, but a way to achieve a positive future for oneself.

I ended up working with an Independent label by the name of N.O.P (Nothing Over Paper).


4. Musical Influences?
